

BELLAIRE AREA



This area of Houston is defined by the 610 highway “loop” and includes the full spectrum of architectural choices, price ranges and lifestyles. Many of these neighborhoods represent Houston oldest communities. As land values have increased and commute times lengthened, older homes are being renovated or replaced with larger new construction to reflect today’s lifestyle choices. City of Bellaire



Bellaire is one of the oldest communities in Houston. It was founded in 1908 and supposedly named Bellaire, “good air”, for its breezes. Bordered by City of West University on the east and City of Houston on its other sides, Bellaire quickly asserted its independence and was incorporated in 1918 with a total population of 200 people. Bellaire now boasts over 16,000 residents with independent fire, police and recreational facilities.

Residents of Bellaire enjoy a small town ambiance with great convenience to all the amenities of Houston. The controlled growth and top ranked schools found here make this a wonderful, family oriented community. The City boasts thirteen parks and recreational facilities including a new aquatic center for community enjoyment. Bellaire High School is an exemplary school known for its large number of national merit scholars and outstanding sports programs. 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Meyerland
